Demand Electrification Policy

- Promote sectoral roadmaps to replace fossil fuel consumption with renewable electricity.
- Lower electricity prices for end users, making them more competitive with fossil fuels and firewood.

Energy Security

- Ensure a reliable and resilient electricity system in the face of variability and extreme events.
- Strengthen the grid with large-scale storage and smart networks for greater flexibility and certainty.

National Strategy for Storage and Smart Grids

- Declare storage (BESS) as critical and priority infrastructure.
- Modernize networks toward smart systems that integrate demand and reduce curtailment.

Regulatory Modernization and Permitting with Socioenvironmental Criteria

- Streamline permits with early participation and strategic territorial planning.
- Strengthen the State's capacity to regulate at the pace of innovation.

Just and Binding Territorial Transition

- Fund the Just Transition Strategy focusing on labor reconversion and environmental remediation.
- Make citizen participation binding and promote distributed and local generation.

Latin American Cooperation and Integration

- Lead at COP30 a regional energy integration agreement.
- Optimize resources, strengthen energy security, and access climate finance.

Health and Electrification

 Promote electrification to generate health cobenefits.
